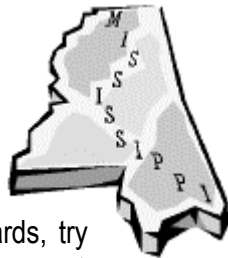

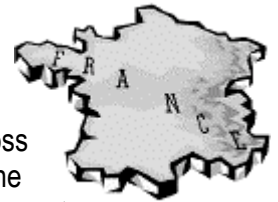
Riverboat Jazz
